House Activities						
We follow the British school tradition of 'houses'. On arrival students are placed into one of three houses. Each house has a name and a colour. All students work together in these houses during activity sessions and ultimately compete against the two other houses towards the end of the week. This system creates a sense of identity, community, team building and collaboration. It helps build friendships across cultures and gives further motivation to each activity. Daytime house activities include performing arts, debating skills, artistic projects, science club and physical activities including sport. Activities are organised on a rotation basis. Many evening activities are organised in the form of a competition, with points being awarded to each house. The winning house is announced at the end of each week.
