You'll create your own personal art storybook as you explore decisive moments in art history, choosing artworks from the different ages. Follow great art and artists from the time of cave paintings to the 21st century. Learn about the methods and techniques they used. Work in different media to discover their qualities and enjoy experimenting.

Taught by a professional art tutor, your sessions will include drawing, painting and printing. You'll be guided throughout the process as you produce a book to showcase your unfolding personal story with the arts. Our camp is for all abilities and interests - no prior art knowledge or skills required!
