Accommodation Details

Homestay Accommodation

Our host families are personally selected and inspected by the school. Students share a twin room, with a student of a different nationality (or same, if preferred). Breakfast and dinner are provided by the family, and a hot lunch is provided on campus on school days. On evenings with an activity, a hot dinner is also provided on campus. In Southampton, homestay students are given a bus pass, while in the New Forest, hosts provide transport. Students have activities on some evenings, while others are spent with the homestay host.

Residential Accommodation

We offer en-suite rooms in modern and secure university halls of residence. All meals are taken at the university canteen. Wi-Fi is available to students at certain locations around the campus (a small charge may apply). Residential students have activities every evening. See website for more details.
